



## Open Ended Homework - Year 1 - Spring Term 1 2020



### Maths at home

- Read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words, e.g. 1 and one; 2 and two.
- Count forwards and backwards from any number between 0-100.
- Add and subtract using numbers to 20. *Chn can draw marks, make their own number lines or use objects to help work out the answer.*
- Practise solving word problems involving addition and subtraction.

*Homework will be set each Friday using MyMaths. Each child will have an individual login.*

### Spelling at home

Children should continue to practise the year 1 common exception words (see sheet attached). They can also identify spellings in and around the home.

Practise spelling the days of the week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

### Reading at home

Encourage your child to read a variety of texts e.g. recipes, instructions, fiction and non-fiction texts. Continue to read home-school books and return to school each Wednesday, ready for a new book each Friday. When children are reading encourage them to 'sound out' words (when necessary) and ask a variety of questions to develop their understanding. Continue to practise recalling the phonemes (sounds) on the sound mat provided.

### Science

This half term, our Science topic is **Animals, including Humans**

**Key Vocabulary:** body, senses, nose, smell, eyes, sight, hands, touch, ears, hear, mouth, taste, amphibians, reptiles, mammals, fish, birds

#### Learning at home ideas:

- Draw and label parts of the human body
- Create a fact file about the role of the different parts of the body/5 senses.
- Find out facts about different types of animals, e.g. amphibians, reptiles, mammals, birds and fish.

### Art/DT

The children will be linking their art work to their learning about London. They will be learning how to design, make and evaluate their product.

#### Learning at home ideas:

- Draw pictures of London landmarks.
- Design and make a London landmark.

### History

This half term, the children will be learning about **The Great Fire of London.**

**Key Vocabulary:** bakery, Pudding Lane, Samuel Pepy's, diary, burning, poor

#### Learning at home ideas:

- Carry out research about The Great Fire of London and create a fact file (with an adult).
- Create a fire picture using any materials, e.g. crayons, chalks, paper.

### PSHCE

#### Learning at home ideas:

Talk about the people who you trust/what a good friend is.

Watch Pantosaurus and discuss.
