

Open Ended Homework - Year 1 - Spring Term 2 2020



Maths at home

- Read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words, e.g. 1 and one; 2 and two.
- Write matching addition and subtraction number sentences, e.g. if 12 + 3 = 15, 15 3 = 12.
- o Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Practise solving multiplication and division word problems, e.g. There are 20 buttons. Each child gets 5 buttons each. How many children can have some buttons?

Homework will be set each Friday using MyMaths.

Spelling at home

Children should continue to practise the year 1 common exception words.

They can also identify spellings in and around the home.

Practise these spellings: people, their, looked, would, could, should, asked, water, where, who, again, work, many

Reading at home

Encourage your child to read a variety of texts e.g. recipes, instructions, fiction and non-fiction texts. Continue to read home-school books and return to school each Wednesday, ready for a new book each Friday. When children are reading encourage them to 'sound out' words (when necessary) and ask a variety of questions to develop their understanding. Continue to practise recalling the phonemes (sounds) on the sound mat provided.

Science

This half term, our Science topic is **Animals, including Humans**

Key Vocabulary: animals, reptiles, mammals, amphibians, birds, fish, herbivores, carnivores, omnivores

Learning at home ideas:

- o Name some reptiles, amphibians, mammals, fish and birds and create a fact files about each animal type.
- o Research some animals that are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

Art/DT

The children will be linking their art work to their learning about London. They will be using different media to create different pictures that represent The Great Fire of London. **Learning at home ideas**:

 Explore with paints, crayons, tissue paper etc to create pictures of The Great Fire of London.

Geography

This half term, the children will be learning about our local area.

Key Vocabulary: Colburn, physical features, human features, pictorial map, key **Learning at home ideas**:

- o Talk about the things that you see in the local area
- Draw simple maps of places that you have visited/places you have travelled to.

PSHCE/ICT

Learning at home ideas:

Internet safety

Talk about ways to keep safe online, e.g. not telling people your passwords, your name, address and which school you go to.

RE

The children will be learning about the Easter story and what happened to Jesus.

At home- Draw and write about key events out of the Easter story.
