



Maths at home

- Read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words, e.g.
 1 and one; 2 and two.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Practise using rulers/your hands to measure everyday items around your house and compare them, saying which one is the longest/shortest. Keep a record of this by drawing a picture of the item and then how many cm it is/hands long.
- Practise filling a cup full, empty, half full, nearly full, nearly empty and then order these from the least/the most.
- Money: recognising a 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p and £1. Set up a pretend shop and buy things using the coins.

This half term, our Science topic is Animals, including Humans.

Spelling at home

Children should continue to practise the year 1 common exception words. They can also identify spellings in and around the home.

Practise these spellings: there, their, some, come, house, very, your, you, were, where, friend Days of the week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday

Reading at home

When children are reading encourage them to 'sound out' words (when necessary) and ask a variety of questions to develop their understanding. Continue to practise recalling the phonemes (sounds) on the sound mat provided.

Websites to use to support reading: Teach your Monster to read; Oxford Reading Owl (you have to register but you can read online books).

History

The children will be linking their about Queen Elizabeth 11; Queen Victoria and The Victorian times.
