



## Open Ended Homework - Year 1 – Summer Term 2020



### Maths at home

- Read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words, e.g. 1 and one; 2 and two.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Practise using rulers/your hands to measure everyday items around your house and compare them, saying which one is the longest/shortest. Keep a record of this by drawing a picture of the item and then how many cm it is/hands long.
- Practise filling a cup full, empty, half full, nearly full, nearly empty and then order these from the least/the most.
- Money: recognising a 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p and £1. Set up a pretend shop and buy things using the coins.

### Spelling at home

Children should continue to practise the year 1 common exception words.

They can also identify spellings in and around the home.

Practise these spellings: there, their, some, come, house, very, your, you, were, where, friend  
Days of the week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday

### Reading at home

When children are reading encourage them to 'sound out' words (when necessary) and ask a variety of questions to develop their understanding. Continue to practise recalling the phonemes (sounds) on the sound mat provided.

**Websites** to use to support reading: Teach your Monster to read; Oxford Reading Owl (you have to register but you can read online books).

### Science

This half term, our Science topic is **Animals, including Humans**.

**Key Vocabulary:** animals, reptiles, mammals, amphibians, birds, fish, herbivores, carnivores, omnivores

We will also be learning about the different Seasons: Winter, Spring, Summer and Autumn.

#### Learning at home ideas:

- Name some reptiles, amphibians, mammals, fish and birds and create a fact files about each animal type.
- Research some animals that are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.
- Record signs of Spring and research about different seasons on the internet (with adult supervision).

### History

The children will be linking their about Queen Elizabeth 11; Queen Victoria and The Victorian times.

**Key Vocabulary:** Queen, Victorian, past, present

#### Learning at home ideas:

- Use the internet to learn facts about Queen Elizabeth 11 and Queen Victoria.
- Find out facts about Victorian Life.

### Geography

This half term, the children will be learning about **the Seaside**.

**Key Vocabulary:** seaside, costal towns, beach, bay, harbour, land, sea.

#### Learning at home ideas:

- Draw/create a seaside picture.
- Find out about the seaside town of Scarborough.
- Write a list of things that you would take to the seaside.

### PSHCE

#### Learning at home ideas:

Looking after yourself

Talk about ways to keep yourself clean and safe, e.g. the importance of excersie; the importance of washing and brushing your teeth; the importance of eating healthily.

### RE

The children will be learning about the features of a church and why people go to church (including celebrations).

**At home-** Draw and write about what you know about churches.
