



Open Ended Homework - Year 3 - Summer Term 1 2020



Maths at home We will be looking at fractions.

- Read and write large numbers.
- Use chocolate bars and pizzas to cut food into amount – discuss and write the fraction.
- Jack Hartman multiplication songs on youtube.
- Find Fractions when baking or cooking.
- Practice sharing things like toys or sweets with siblings or family members using fractions. Talk about its similarity to division.
- Practice Division Facts

Homework will be set each week using MyMaths. Each child will have an individual login.

Spelling at home

Children should continue to orally practise the year 3/4 spelling words. Try misspelling them and seeing if you can pick out where they went wrong. Try to learn the lyrics of songs that use these words. Simply writing them in sentences or multiple times on a sheet of paper or typing them on a tablet/phone is also great practice!

Reading at home

- Read a story then have them create a version where they add themselves to the story.
- Have an adult read a book then interview them about it.
- Go online to find pdfs of new and exciting books to read on their tablets
- Have them read recipes out loud to parents or siblings to help in the kitchen

Science

This half term, the children will be learning about **Animals including humans.**

Key Vocabulary: herbivores/carnivores/omnivores, pyramid

Learning at home ideas:

- Do a Joe Wicks workout and take notes of what muscles you are working out.
- Create a menu for a herbivore, carnivore, and omnivore

Geography

This half term, the children will be learning about **Volcanoes.**

Key Vocabulary: Eruption, Tectonic plate, Magma chamber, Main vent, Crater, Lava, Magma

Learning at home ideas:

- Create your own volcano

History

This half term, the children will be learning about the **Romans.**

Key Vocabulary: Gladiator, Britannia, Roman baths, Hadrian's Wall, Boudicca, Villa, Chariot, Toga, Julius Caesar, Myth

Learning at home ideas:

- Create Roman swords and shields
- Watch Horrible Histories: Rotten Romans and create a poster to show what you've learned

RE

This term we would be talking about what makes Jesus an Inspiration to people. Talk in your family about that topic as well as what things or people are an inspiration to you and what that means.

French
